There have been over 90 publicly reported incidents of mishandled guns at schools in the last five years. This includes a teacher's loaded gun falling from his waistband during a cartwheel and a teacher unintentionally firing a gun in class during a safety demonstration. That's why a 2013 Joint State Government Commission on Violence report "strongly opposed" arming non-law enforcement personnel in schools.
